

LOCAL RULES

(These Local Rules are to be read in conjunction with the R&A Rules of Golf).

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18):

A ball coming to rest beyond the perimeter fence/wall of the course is out of bounds. White stakes, where present, also define out of bounds.

2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17):

Penalty areas are defined by yellow stakes and lateral penalty areas are defined by red stakes. Rows of trees with red paint on them also define lateral penalty areas. A player may proceed under the Rules of Golf, or with a 1-stroke penalty use the drop zones provided in holes 02,04,09,10 & 17.

3. Drop Zones:

i) Holes No.2 : The nearer of the two drop zones provided may be used if the ball comes to rest in the penalty area.

ii) Hole 17: If the ball comes to rest in the penalty area which is to the right of the bridge, the drop zone may be used under a 1-stroke penalty. This

drop zone cannot be used if the ball comes to rest in the penalty area between the tee box and the putting green.

4. Lost Ball/Ball Out of Bounds (Rule 18):

The player has the option to not take the stroke and distance penalty; instead for two penalty strokes the player may take relief by dropping in the relief area. The relief area requires the player to establish:

a) Ball Reference Point: The point where the ball is estimated to be lost or last crossed the edge of the boundary of the course.

b) Fairway Reference Point: The point on the fairway nearest to the ball reference point but which is not nearer the hole.

c) Size of Relief Area Based On Reference Points: Anywhere between:

- * A line from the hole through the Ball Reference Point (and within two club lengths to the outside of that line) and
- * A line from the hole through the Fairway Reference Point (and within two club lengths to the fairway side of that line)

But within these limits:

- * Must be in the general area
- * Must not be nearer the hole than the ball reference point.

This option must not be used when a ball is lost in a penalty area or when a provisional ball has been played.

5. Preferred Lie:

When a ball lies in the general area, it may be lifted, cleaned and placed within ONE CLUB LENGTH, not nearer to the hole. The ball must be marked before it is lifted. If the player deems his ball to be unplayable even after availing a preferred lie, he may play under the rule "Ball Unplayable" with a penalty of one stroke:

6. Distance Markers:

Yellow-100 Yds. White-150 Yds. Blue-200 Yds from the centre of the green.

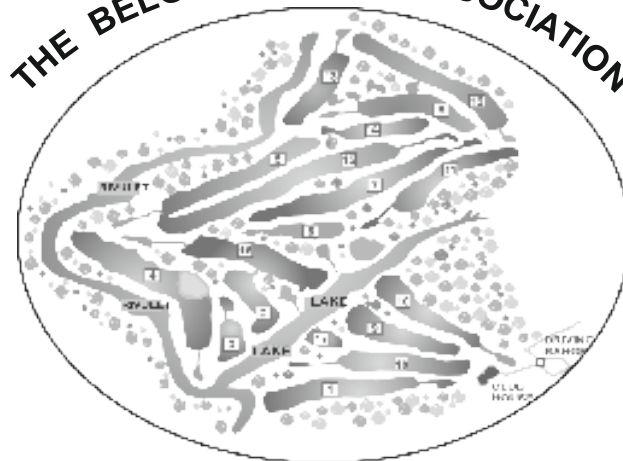
General Penalty for Breach of Local Rule:
